


I. STRANGERS & PILGRIMS

1 Peter 1:1 (NKJV) ¹ Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To the pilgrims of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia

NASBTT: to those who reside as aliens...who are chosen
(NIV) To God's elect, strangers in the world, scattered
(NLT) God's chosen people who are living as foreigners ...
(MSG) ...exiles scattered to the four winds



"STRANGERS" (parepidēmois),

foreign nationality and temporary residence;

Christians, whose citizenship is in heaven, live in the midst of a pagan society as aliens and sojourners, displaced persons

SCATTERED" (diasporas)

The diaspora referred to Jews who were separated from their homeland.

Peter adapted this word to the condition of the early church.

II. A LIVING HOPE

1 Peter 1:3 PASSION: **Celebrate with praises the God** and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who has shown us His extravagant mercy. For His fountain of mercy has given us a new life—we are reborn to experience a *living*, energetic hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

A LIVING HOPE: to anticipate, usually with pleasure; expectation or confidence
