








Proverbs 17:22 A merry heart does good, *like* medicine, but a broken spirit dries the bones.





EZEKIEL 36:26-29

²⁶ I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them. ²⁸ Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; you shall be My people, and I will be your God. ²⁹ I will deliver you from all your uncleannesses...

Ezekiel 37:11-12 NKJV

¹¹ Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, 'Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!' ¹² Therefore prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.

Ezekiel 37:13-14 NKJV

¹³ Then you shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves. ¹⁴ I will put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the LORD, have spoken it and performed it," says the LORD.' "

III. ORDER OF RESPONSE

- 1. WE LIKE to put our HAND out first and tell you what we "SEE."
- 2. What does <u>God</u> have to say about your *gift? Matthew 7:1-5 MSG*

God BEGINS WITH YOUR HEART. THEN, your heart attitude directly IMPACTS WHAT YOU SEE—*and your ability to see ACCURATELY.*

<u>NKJV:</u> Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted

<u>MSG:</u> ... If someone falls into sin, forgivingly restore him, saving your critical comments for yourself. You might be needing forgiveness before the day's out.
