(TPT) Your words are so powerful that they will kill or give life...

# **Psalm 141:3**

(NKJV) <sup>3</sup> Set a guard, O LORD, over my mouth; Keep watch over the door of my lips.

(NLT2) <sup>3</sup> Take control of what I say, O LORD, and guard my lips.

(MSG) <sup>3</sup> Post a guard at my mouth, GOD, set a watch at the door of my lips.

(TPT) God, give me grace to guard my lips from speaking what is wrong.





17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.


# III. YOUR WORDS
