# **I. JESUS WANTS TO MEET WITH YOU**

**John 11:28-31 (NKJV)**

***she went her way and secretly called Mary her sister, saying, "The Teacher has come and is calling for you." <sup>29</sup> As soon as she heard that, she arose quickly and came to Him.***

## II. THE REPORT OF THE LORD

John 11:33-40 (NKJV)

**33** Therefore, when Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who came with her weeping, He ***groaned*** in the spirit and was ***troubled***. **34** And He said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to Him, "Lord, come and see."



# 35 Jesus wept.



**Groaned**: (to *snort* with anger); to have *indignation on*, i.e. to *blame*, to *sigh* with chagrin, (special) to sternly *enjoin*.

**TROUBLED**: tarasso-- to *stir* or *agitate* (*roil* water)

**John 11:36-38 (NKJV)**

***36 Then the Jews said,  
"See how He loved him!"***

***37 And some of them said, "Could not this Man, who opened the eyes of the blind, also have kept this man from dying?" 38 Then Jesus, again **groaning** in Himself, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay against it.***

***39 Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been dead four days."***
