### **DILIGENT: MAKE EFFORT**

PRESENT YOURSELF: SHOW AND SUBSTANTIATE YOURSELF

APPROVED: ACCEPTABLE, TRIED

WORKER: TOILER, TEACHER

NOT ASHAMED: ABOVE SUSPICION, BLAMELESS, FAULTESS, GUILTLESS, HONEST, INNOCENT, SPOTLESS, UNASSAILABLE

RIGHTLY DIVIDING: TO MAKE A STRAIGHT CUT, TO DISSECT, EXPOUND CORRECTLY
